- Encouraged but not required to teach children, youth and adults throughout the internship.
- Will assist the Office Staff, as available, with general office duties as needed.

Requirements for Eligibility

- Complete application by the posted deadline & turn into the Unity Office.

- Must be a High School Graduate, with a heart for ministry.
- Must be able to work a flexible 20 hrs/wk.
- Must complete background check & Ministry Safe training before beginning.
- Must complete the Intern Orientation provided by the SBC of Virginia. (Date TBD)
- Will be required to serve up to one week at one SBC of Virginia event as needed.
